How to Use the Celebration Center in the Home

- What we focus on, we get more of... so when we focus on our children's varied accomplishments and successes, we will get more of those accomplishments and successes! A Celebration Center celebrates life events, individual achievements, and contributions to the family, school, or community.
- A Celebration Board is a place to highlight your child's accomplishments, whether big or small, traditional or unusual, academic or social, milestone or everyday event. And remember, celebrating isn't about giving a reward or being the best; it's about honoring your child's efforts! Events to celebrate might include losing a tooth, learning to ride a bicycle, birthdays, improving a spelling score, or helping a friend through a difficult time..
- The manner you choose to celebrate is determined by your family's personality, but be certain it is based on a ritual (an interaction), not a tangible reward like money or food.
 - Rituals include eye contact, touch, presence and playfulness. Your celebration might include singing a special song together, offering high fives around the kitchen table, or doing an I Love You Ritual together as a family in honor of the person you are celebrating.

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
