## Instructions

1. As you say this line, turn your child's hands so they are facing you, palms out. As you say the next line, give the child's hand a nice squeeze.
2. Touch each finger on one hand as you say each word of the line.
3. Touch the fingers of the other hand. Since there are six words in this line, say one word per finger except for "to do." Say these together while touching the last finger.
4. Fold the child's fingers into a fist and put both your hands around the child's hand, as though you are swaddling the child's hand in your hands.
5. Rock the child's hand from side to side.
6. Press the child's hand against his or her chest. This will place you in a slight hugging position.
7. Say these words lovingly and give the child a hug.
